SWEET MUSIC IN HEAVEN

Revelation 19:6

“And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth..”

The theme of the song of ministering angels and redeemed sinners is that of praise to the Lord God, the Lord Jesus Christ. And that which is the keynote of rejoicing in this song is the absolute reign of the Christ of God. Is anything more comforting to a child of God than this: **“the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.”** Our Triumphant Savior – When Moses led the children of Israel in singing on the other side of the Red Sea, this was their theme.

“Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea.” And so will that multitude that no man can number, those who came out of great tribulation, who have followed the Lamb to be where He is. And they will sing in perfect harmony, with undivided hearts, **“Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth..”**

Our Comfort – Everything that Moses sang about at the Red Sea, all that followed in that glorious song of praise to God, was dependent on the truth of that first note, God’s absolute sovereignty. None of those blessed things they sung about would have ever happened otherwise. And when all those chosen, redeemed, and called are gathered around the throne of God, we read: **“And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.”**

Gladness and Joy – I can think of no one that would not be glad and rejoice in this wonderful truth about the omnipotence of the Lord Jesus Christ except a rebel. And that is what you are if you have never bowed to God’s Son. And you will bow, now in surrender to Him as your great God and Savior, or you will bow before Him as your righteous Judge. May He bring you to Himself by His mighty reigning grace this very hour!
